The Vincent Blakley Memorial Award is an award in reembrance of the late Vincent Blakley. This \$500 cash award is available to seniors that will be graduating in May of 2025 who have exhibited an animal at the Rogers County Fair. Vincent Blakley was a longtime supporter of the Rogers County Fair. He was a man that understood the values a show projects can instill in young people. Vincent was a resident of Rogers County his entire life. He dedicated his life to helping 4-H and FFA members in the junior livestock program. Vincent was the Beef Superintendent at the Rogers County Fair for 28 years. He was a prestigious cattlemen that valued his family and the agricultural way of life, but what he enjoyed the most was watching his children and grandchildren exhibit cattle all across the country.

Purpose:

- To recognize hard-working, dedicated young people who show an interest in the livestock industry.
- To assist students who exhibit the standards of excellence demonstrated through 4-H and FFA projects.
- To encourage leadership development through livestock projects.
- To bring awareness of the importance of agriculture and the values of the livestock industry.

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a resident of Rogers County.
- Applicant must be a high school senior.
- Applicant must have a 2.5 GPA or Higher.
- Applicant does **not** have to attend a secondary school following graduation.

Requirements:

- Applicant must submit a typed essay of 750 words or less describing “the benefits you received from exhibiting livestock at the Rogers County Fair, the effect that experience had on your life, how it may have influenced your career choice and how you plan to give back to the junior livestock program”.
- Applicant must submit one letter of reference from a teacher, advisor or extension agent.
- Applicant must submit a letter from their high school that they are in good academic standing. (please do not send your transcript)
