2019 was a year of change! The sale launched a Facebook Event Page to get the word out and added the option to make donations by credit card. The biggest change was bringing all 81 4-H and FFA livestock exhibitors and their livestock inside the sale arena building to celebrate their achievements. Community members were able to meet the exhibitors and see their livestock up close before the sale. It was an exciting night and a great sale!

Working in collaboration with the County Fair Board, the Rogers County Premium Auction Committee (RCPAC) hosts the premium sale each year. This letter shares with you the financial summary presented at our RCPAC annual meeting. We would like to thank you for supporting the Premium Sale and the young exhibitors who are the future of agriculture in Rogers County.

Each sale participant receives a detailed statement showing their ring bid, their add-on donations, and their deductions. A 4% commission is deducted from each participant's check which goes to the general fund. The general fund covers all the expenses the RCPAC incurs in conducting the sale and operating the organization. In 2019, general fund support to sale participants was \$6075.00 (3%); our operating expenses were \$5914.08 (3%).
