

RSU sponsors the Senior Showmanship Scholarships for the champion senior showman in the Beef, Dairy, Swine, Sheep, Goat, and Horse Shows. Exhibitors must comply with all eligibility requirements of General Rule #9. The exhibitor does not have to be a senior in high school to win (e.g. may be a junior (11th grade) and win the senior division of showmanship.) If the exhibitor has already won the Senior Showmanship Scholarship in a previous year, they may compete in showmanship for placing and other prizes but are not eligible to win the scholarship a second time. In the case of the Champion Senior Division Showman having already won the scholarship, the scholarship will be awarded to the next highest placing senior showman who has not previously won this award. The scholarship is not transferable. This scholarship is sponsored by RSU and the winner must meet admission standards at RSU.

Terms of Senior Showmanship Scholarships

- RSU will provide a \$1,000 tuition waiver scholarship to the senior showmanship division winner in Beef, Dairy, Swine, Sheep, Goat, Horse Divisions.
- Winner is not required to be a senior in high school.
- These scholarships are to be used for the recipient's freshman school year and require full-time attendance at RSU.
- The scholarships provide \$500/semester in tuition and fee assistance for the fall and spring semesters.
- These are one-year awards. Total value is \$1000.
- A recipient may win this scholarship one time.
