ALL INDOOR EXHIBITS & CONTESTS entries are to be done online.

ALL LIVESTOCK AND ANIMAL entries are to be done online. The process is very similar to indoor exhibits. Please enter everything you think you may show. At check-in you can let us know what animals you are NOT checking in. There will be no new entries on the day of check-in.

More Details on Entries

- All indoor entries including fine arts and livestock/animals will be done on www.Fairentry.com
- You will create an account for each exhibitor
- Then pre-enter your items/animals. Then check-in items you are exhibiting at the fair on the scheduled day. This is an easy process of scanning your entry info for the items/animals you bring to the fair.
- We suggest pre-entry for EVERYTHING you <u>may</u> exhibit. It is very easy to <u>not</u> check in the items/ animals you decide not to bring to the Fair.
- Day of check-in is not the time to do your initial entry of items/animals for the fair. This results in long lines. PLEASE pre-enter online by August 29th.

NOTE: There will be NO new entries taken on the day of check-in for livestock.
